NOTICE FOR FAILURE TO PROVIDE ACCESS FOR REMEDIATION

TO: Class Action Property Owners and Residents:

This Notice is provided to you by the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Louisiana, regarding the Murphy Oil USA, Inc. ("Murphy") oil spill that occurred in St. Bernard Parish after Hurricane Katrina.

On August 9, 2006, the Court issued an Order Requiring Access to all properties within the Court's Certified Class Area to Implement the EPA-LDEQ-ATSDR-LDHH-Approved Remediation Plan. Pursuant to the Court's Order, and in accordance with the Remediation Plan approved by the governmental regulatory agencies charged with overseeing Murphy's remediation efforts, Murphy is in the process of remediating properties within the Class Area.

In the event that you prevent or your actions impede Murphy from accessing your property to effectuate the Remediation Plan, this Notice serves as formal, written notice that you will be ordered to appear before the Court and may incur fines at a rate of \$100.00/day for every day that you prevent or otherwise impede remediation. This Order is deemed necessary by the Court to comply with the Remediation Plan and to not allow a small minority of property owners

in the Class Area to delay remediation and thereby harm the overall recovery effort in St. Bernard Parish.
