ORDER

The "Ex Parte Motion for Leave of Court to Exceed Page Limit on the Memorandum in Support of the Manufacturer Defendants' Motion for Rule 37 Sanctions Against the Direct Purchaser Plaintiffs," Record Doc. No. 294, is DENIED. Consideration of the underlying motion for sanctions will proceed as follows:

IT IS ORDERED that no later than July 23, 2013, Manufacturer Defendants must re-file their memorandum in support of the motion. The re-filed memorandum must not exceed 15 pages and must briefly list/summarize in plain English their discovery complaints and provide concrete examples of each.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all exhibits submitted with the underlying motion are hereby STRICKEN FROM THE RECORD. No exhibits of any kind may be attached to the re-filed memorandum, unless the court later orders them to be filed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that no later than July 29, 2013, Direct Purchaser Plaintiffs must file their memorandum in opposition to the underlying motion for

sanctions. The opposition memorandum must not exceed 15 pages and no exhibits of any kind may be attached to it.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a status conference to consider this matter will be conducted by Chief Judge Vance and me on August 1, 2013 at 11:00 a.m. in the Chief Judge's chambers. Attendance at the status conference is hereby limited to two lawyers for the Manufacturer Defendants (one liaison counsel and one other lawyer); two lawyers for the Direct Purchaser Plaintiffs (one liaison counsel and one other lawyer); and William B. Gaudet, defendants' liaison counsel, all of whom must appear in person.
