**ORDER**

Considering the foregoing Motion of the Special Master:

**IT IS ORDERED** that any claimant, whose claim has had a determination on eligibility for payment under the terms and provisions of the Resolution Program I, who objects to his/her medical records in the possession of the Special Master being destroyed, must file a written objection with the Court no later than Wednesday, April 15, 2009 and show cause on Wednesday, April 22, 2009 at 9:00 a.m. why such records should not be destroyed;

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that all medical records on claimants, who have had a determination on eligibility for payment under the terms and provisions of the Resolution Program I and who do not file a timely objection, shall be destroyed at the direction of the Special Master; and
