**ORDER FOR EXPEDITING OF OUTSTANDING CLAIMS IN PROPULSID I  
RESOLUTION PROGRAM**

The foregoing Joint Motion for the Expediting of Outstanding Claims in Propulsid I Resolution Program be considered:

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

(1) For all claims that the Special Master has recently cleared for defense briefing, or clears in the future, such claims may be submitted to the Medical Panel for eligibility determination without a complete defense briefing, in accordance with the Program's Term Sheet, using only those medical records that claimants have previously submitted.

(2) In the event that the Medical Panel determines that any claim referenced in (1) meets the eligibility criteria, Defendants shall have the exclusive right to seek re-examination of said determination. In the event that Defendants exercise this right,

Defendants shall have the opportunity to obtain additional medical records and to submit new or revised confidential memoranda to the Special Master for consideration by a set of two Panelists different from the Panelists who made the eligibility determination with such submission to be made within 60 days, except when the Special Master determines good cause exists for additional time for such defense submission.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
