PRETRIAL ORDER NO. 20
NOTICE TO COUNSEL IN ALL CASES

I. APPLICABILITY OF ORDER

This Order shall govern all cases currently in MDL 1355 and all cases that are transferred after the entry of this Order into MDL 1355.

II. LEXIS NEXIS FILE & SERVE

The Court has been informed that Verilaw Technologies, Inc. has migrated to Lexis Nexis File & Serve Advanced ("Lexis Nexis File & Serve") and that a number of counsel have not complied with the registration provisions of Lexis Nexis File & Serve that are necessary for the migration to be completed. As previously ordered in Pre-Trial Order No. 4, all service is to be accomplished by uploading filings to Lexis Nexis File & Serve (formerly Verilaw.) Liaison Counsel previously served documents via Verilaw and, as a result of the migration, is expected to continue to serve documents via Lexis Nexis File & Serve. It is the responsibility of all counsel to register with Lexis Nexis File & Serve in order to continue to receive filings made with the Court and service of pleadings in this case. Failure to register with Lexis Nexis File & Serve shall be deemed a desire by counsel not to receive further filings in this matter. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that effective immediately, all service shall be via Lexis Nexis File & Serve. Attorneys who fail to register will no longer receive service of documents filed in the MDL.
